

Sketch 3 Comment:

The third shows the core length, assays and position vertically and horizontally of drill intersections to the date indicated, on a longitudinal section of our new C-3 copper/gold zone. The shape of the 85-3 zone of the Copper Rand deposit from the previous sketch has been transposed onto the C-3 longitudinal section in order to provide an idea of scale and to demonstrate that, combined with the previous longitudinal sketch, only a very small area has been tested on the Bateman Bay property, that copper/gold zones often occur in multiples and that the shapes are irregular. One orebody often is an indicator of the potential of finding other orebodies nearby. Due to the irregular shapes and number of zones that can make up a minable deposit such as the nearby Copper Rand mine, much drilling is required.
